Minutes of the Radnor Township Board of Trustees

May 28, 2019

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The Radnor Township Board of Trustees met on Tuesday, May 28, 2019 at 7:00 PM at the Radnor Community Center.

Those present were Dan Boyssel, Teresa Watkins, Dave Weber, Jenifer Way-Young from the Delaware General Health District, Bob Fish and John Coonfare.

Dan called the meeting to order and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Minutes of the May 13, 2019 meeting were read. Dave moved to approve the May 13, 2019 meeting minutes and Teresa seconded.

Ms. Way-Young provided the Board of Trustees with an update on the current national measles outbreak. Currently, there are no confirmed cases in Delaware County and the DGHD is providing the two (2) dose MMR Vaccination.

Ms. Way-Young advised the Board of Trustees that Radnor Township was awarded the grant from the Ohio EPA for improvements to the recycling area at the park. Grant funding includes monies to be used for a new concrete pad for the recycle bins, two (2) solar powered security cameras and signage for the immediate area.

The Board of Trustees were presented with the Fiscal Year 2020 DGHD assessment of \$2,150.71 under provisions of Section 5705.28 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Bob provided the Board of Trustees with an estimate for replacing the damaged overhead door in the fire bay. The cost to replace the door is \$2,500.00. This cost also includes reinforcing the existing three (3) other doors. Integrity Door Sales will replace all four (4) fire bay overhead doors for \$7,999.48. Since the doors are in excess of twenty (20) years old, Dave moved to replace all four (4) of the overhead fire bay doors for \$7,999.48 and Teresa seconded. All aye.


Bob and the Board of Trustees discussed the location of the new diesel fuel tank at the fire department. Electric access to the tank is the biggest consideration for their location. Randy will be consulted and a final determination for its location will be made.

Dan stated that a private resident had requested permission to run a field tile culvert under River Road to alleviate drainage issues in the immediate area. The resident will be referred to the Delaware County Engineer for regulations regarding public road right of way laws.

The Board of Trustees will assess the condition of the Township roads during a road tour in conjunction with the Delaware County Engineer on Thursday, May 30, 2019.

There being no further business, Dave moved to adjourn and Teresa seconded.
