Call to Order and Roll Call

The Radnor Township Board of Trustees met in regular session on Monday, October 27, 2025 at 8:00 AM at the Radnor Township Community Center, 4061 State Route 203, Radnor, Ohio. Trustee Boysel called the meeting to order and the roll was called; attending were Trustees Dan Boysel, Cameron James and Dave Weber.

Approval of Minutes

Mr. Boysel moved and Mr. James seconded to approve the meeting minutes with corrections, for October 13, 2025. Vote: Boysel, aye; Weber, aye; James, aye. Motion passed.

Public Input

- Joe Clase, Plan 4 Land, provided the Board with an update on park improvements. The grant received is for \$160,000.00; allow about \$156,800.00. It is a reimbursement grant. Breaking ground will occur in mid-November with a special public meeting at the park for a ceremony.

Fire Department

- September 2025 run report was handed out.
- Truck iPods are needed for CAD Integration by January 1, 2026 to meet all other districts in county; a quote from Verizon was obtained. An updated second quote from First Net will be collected prior to Board decision.
- New brush truck will be in service as of today.
- Four new firefighters are beginning orientation. Applications are still being reviewed as they come in and interviews are being held; Chief Butts stated he would like to get employee number back up to 28.
- Board was notified of missing email and documents are missing from prior Chief and Assistant Chief email accounts; district email folder is empty; paper run reports are missing. Board will contact Delaware County Prosecutor's office for assistance.

Road/Maintenance Department

- Penry Rd. and Hodges Rd. berming has been completed. Berm box and road mower attachments will be removed and snow plows will be installed prior to November.
- Todd called for lines to be marked on Byers Rd.; hopefully it will be completed this week.
- Trimming in cemetery is about done and the concession stand at the baseball fields has been winterized.

Board Report

- Cameron James stated Pam Jones is requesting \$150.00 for drone footage and other miscellaneous expenditures for Wreaths Across America. Dan offered to personally pay for the expense.
- Dan Boysel discussed the weight limit on Penry Rd., as he was contacted by Troy Township regarding the road.

- Mr. James moved and Mr. Weber seconded to approve pending warrants detailed in payment listing detail report for October 14, 2025 through October 31, 2025. Vote: Boysel, aye; James, aye; Weber, aye. Motion passed.
