Call to Order and Roll Call

Chairperson Boysel called the meeting to order and the roll was called; attending were Trustees Dan Boysel, Dave Weber, and Cameron James.

Public Input

 Donna Meyer was present and asked questions regarding the job posting for the part time Fire Chief. She also inquired about the progress on her public records request.

Fire Department

- Brad Bellville spoke about an opportunity to set up a farm fire safety center at a local agricultural location. This will give Radnor an opportunity to train in bin safety, ladder truck use, etc. The Department will continue to review the idea.
- Thank you to the crews who responded to the two fatal scenes in the last week. A debriefing/counseling session was set up at the Township Hall.
- Three interviews are being scheduled for additional firefighters. Offers should follow soon.
- The grass truck is over 20 years old. Department will review specifications to order a new one and also look at remedial options such as skid units to keep the current truck in service.

Road/Maintenance Department

- Tree trimming on River Road north of Hoskins Road should take about a day.
- The disinterment at the cemetery went well and is complete. The paperwork is required to be submitted by the applicant within 30 days.

Trustee Updates

- Park committee is meeting on Thursday September 11, at the township hall to rework the construction plans as the concrete has been donated by Ernst Concrete and the aggregate by National Stone, which frees additional grant funds for more park improvements.
