Call to Order and Roll Call

The Radnor Township Board of Trustees met in regular session on Monday, February 23, 2026 at 6:30 PM at the Radnor Township Community Center, 4061 State Route 203, Radnor, Ohio. Trustee Boysel called the meeting to order and the roll was called; attending were Trustees Dan Boysel, Cameron James, and Donna Meyer.

Approval of Minutes

- Mr. Boysel moved and Mrs. Meyer seconded to approve the meeting minutes for January 26, 2026 as written and the meeting minutes for February 9, 2026 with corrections. Vote: Boysel, aye; James, aye; Meyer, aye. Motion passed.

Public Input

- Thompson Township Trustee Kent Manley notified the Board that Thompson Township's fire levy goes through 2028. Mr. Manley also thanked the Radnor Township Fire Department for their presence at Dan Huffman's funeral.
- Ric Stranges, Superintendent for Buckeye Valley Local School District, spoke of making the rounds to all the township meeting as he is trying to create a good relationship between BVLS and the surrounding townships.

Fire Department

- January run report given and discussed with Board.
- Three (3) new hires recommended to the Board: Victoria Yurjevic, Zach Wolfe, and Evan Wolfe. Mr. James moved and Mrs. Meyer seconded to hire all three candidates. Vote: Boysel, aye; James, aye; Meyer, aye. Motion passed. This brings the total number of firefighters to 29; the goal is to have 32.
- Chief Greg Butts recommended promotion for five (5) individuals: Steve Belville to Deputy Chief, Brian Rider to Captain, Kyle Williams to Captain, Kip Millhoan to Lieutenant, and Ben Moder to Lieutenant. The purpose for the title promotion is to have at least one officer on each shift to clearly identify chain of command. Mr. James moved and Mrs. Meyer seconded all promotions. Vote: Boysel, aye; James, aye; Meyer, aye. Motion passed.
- Mr. Moder discussed a mobile air trailer the FD would like to purchase for the purpose of utilizing the trailer during runs to fill bottles as needed; the cost of the trailer is \$60,000.00. Mr. James moved and Mrs. Meyer seconded the purchase. Vote: Boysel, aye; James, aye; Meyer, aye. Motion passed.
- The Board and Fire Department plan to hold another work session meeting on Wednesday, February 25, 2026 at 6:30 PM.

Road/Maintenance Department

- Doug Riedel, Delaware County Engineer's Office, provided the Board with the OPWC estimate for N. Sectionline Rd.; Radnor's portion for the project is \$24,530.05. Mr. Boysel moved and Mr. James seconded to accept and sign the estimate. Vote: Boysel, aye; James, aye; Meyer, aye. Motion passed.
- Hoskins Road culvert repair options were discussed; Mr. Riedel will get an estimate with two options.
- Jones Road estimate is still being worked up, should be ready for the next Board meeting in March.
- REA signed for Penry Rd. (east of 203) for the Engineer's office to look at the series of three pipes that are flooding.

Board Report

- Mr. James spoke with Todd Coonfare and relayed his message regarding maintenance department updates: salt barn is stocked and they have been busy salting roads; wants to put up a green fence on north side of park property; plans to haul all metal and trash to junk yard.
- Mrs. Meyer updated the Board on plans for the park: she met with Joe Clase, Plan4Land, to go over plans and possible changes; stakes will be placed on Wednesday at 9 AM and work will begin; residents' property is again on the township park property, Mr. James will be on site Wednesday to handle the situation; March 12, 2026 is the deadline to apply to the state for grant funds for the park; additionally, Donna wants to start a fundraising campaign for the park.
- Mr. Boysel discussed the upcoming DCTA meeting and Comprehensive Planning Committees monthly meetings. Dan reached out to Schumacher Group to set up a meeting in the beginning of March to prepare for updating the township's website.

Financials/Fiscal Officer

- The payment listing for February 10, 2026 through February 23, 2026 was provided to the Board. Mr. Boysel moved and Mrs. Meyer seconded to approve the payment listing. Vote: Boysel, aye; James, aye; Meyer, aye. Motion passed.

Old Business

- Fire Chief's Association consulting available; can attend a March Board meeting for explanation on what they are able to do for the township.
