Minutes of the Radnor Township Board of Trustees

March 9, 2026

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Call to Order and Roll Call

The Radnor Township Board of Trustees met in regular session on Monday, March 6, 2026 at 6:30 PM at the Radnor Township Community Center, 4061 State Route 203, Radnor, Ohio. Trustee ^{James}Boysel called the meeting to order and the roll was called; attending were Trustees Cameron James and Donna Meyer. Absent: Dan Boyssel.

Approval of Minutes

- Mrs. Meyer moved and Mr. James seconded to approve the meeting minutes for February 23, 2026 as written and the special meeting minutes for February 25, 2026 as written. Vote: James, aye; Meyer, aye. Motion passed.

Public Input

- Frank Cook, Ohio Fire Chief's Association, provided the Board and fire department information pertaining to services offered for assistance and guidance for creating a joint fire district. Mr. Cook recommends a joint fire district feasibility study, which would allow the elected officials to gather and review data related to decisions. The earliest start date Mr. Cook is available is mid to late summer and the study takes approximately 4-5 months to compile everything for the Board. Mrs. Meyer informed Mr. Cook that the Board is looking for information on costs, process, etc. for Radnor Township to join Tri-Township Fire District, not create a new district. The Board agreed a feasibility study would be wonderful, however decisions regarding the Fire Levy need to be completed by August 2026.

Fire Department

- Truck and equipment maintenance report provided by Chief Greg Butts and Asst. Chief Brad Belville.
- Discussion regarding the need to purchase a mower for fire dept. use resulted in Mr. James seeking quotes for a new mower as the township maintenance dept. does not have a spare.
- The spaghetti dinner fundraiser for the fire dept. association was well attended.

Road/Maintenance Department

- Doug Riedel, Delaware County Engineer's Office, provided two options for Hoskins Rd.; the Board will discuss at their next meeting. Mr. Riedel also discussed the Jones Rd. estimate, equaling \$58,265.35, which would not be done until 2027.
- Todd Coonfare provided an update on road and maintenance dept. information, including tree trimmings that occurred on River Rd. and the garage door being replaced at the maintenance building. Mr. Coonfare also stated new flags will need to be purchased and requested buying the heavy-duty flags for approximately \$500.00; Mrs. Meyer moved and Mr. James seconded the approval of the purchase. Vote: James, aye; Meyer, aye. Motion passed.

Board Report

- Mrs. Meyer gave an update on park improvements and also discussed vandalism that occurred at the park; the Board plans on discussing obtaining a security camera for the park/baseball fields at their next meeting.
- Mr. James signed the attorney certification paperwork; Mrs. Wheeland will send to Joe Clase.

Financials/Fiscal Officer

- The payment listing for March 1, 2026 through March 9, 2026 was provided to the Board. Mrs. Meyer moved and Mr. James seconded to approve the payment listing. Vote: James, aye; Meyer, aye. Motion passed.
- The Board signed the January 2026 Bank Reconciliation.
- Mrs. Wheeland discussed payment status of Delaware County Regional Planning and the EMA snowfall emergency reimbursement.


Executive Session




