Minutes of the Radnor Township Board of Trustees

April 27, 2020

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The Radnor Township Board of Trustees met on Monday, April 27, 2020 at 7:00 PM at the Radnor Community Center.

Those present were: Teresa Watkins, Dave Weber, Dan Boysel, Randy Butts, Todd Coonfare, and Katarina Wheeland.

Teresa called the meeting to order and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Minutes of the March ²³ ~~9~~, 2020 meeting were read. Dan moved to approve the March 23, 2020 meeting minutes and Dave seconded.

Randy reported to the Board of Trustees that the Fire Department is postponing the Memorial Day Hog Roast. He advised that the Memorial Day Parade and ceremony at the cemetery be cancelled as well. The Trustees agreed and a notice will be placed at the Post Office, Township Hall, and in the Delaware Gazette. Randy hopes to reschedule the Hog Roast at a later date, when the threat of COVID-19 has subsided.

Randy requested an update regarding the electrical upgrades for the Fire Department. Dan stated that he has not heard from INDCO as far as a start date is concerned.

Randy notified the Board of Trustees that all community center rentals have been cancelled for May due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Randy advised the Board of Trustees on the status of repairs to several fire engines. Teresa requested a status on the purchase of the new engine. Randy will get together with Bob Fish to have more information for the Trustees by May 26, 2020.

Todd advised the Board of Trustees that signs around the township have been stolen. Dave has notified the Delaware County Sheriff regarding the thefts. Todd noted that only one of the many signs needed to be immediately replaced; the others will be replaced at a later date.


Todd reported he met with Tony Fisher from Timberland Tree and Dave Weber regarding the tree trimming in the cemetery. He suggests they cable the tree in the cemetery by the well, as well as trim the top of the tree. He also advised the board remove two trees at the community center.

Dave stated he will be getting a quote for tiles that need jetted.

Teresa updated the board that Jennifer Way-Young of the Delaware General Health District advised that the grant project is going to cost more than expected. However, monies may be coming from other sources to cover the cost.

The Board of Trustees determined that due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, the regularly scheduled meeting for May 11, 2020 will be cancelled and the next meeting of the Radnor Township Board of Trustees will be Tuesday, May 26, 2020 at 7:00 PM.
