The Radnor Township Board of Trustees met on Monday, February 24, 2020 at 7:00 PM at the Radnor Community Center.

Those present were: Teresa Watkins, Dave Weber, Dan Boysel, Delaware Township Trustee Randy Ormeroid, Jenifer Way-Young from the Delaware General Health District, Katarina Wheeland, Todd Coonfare and John Coonfare.

Teresa called the meeting to order and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Minutes of the February 10, 2020 meeting were read. Dan moved to approve the February 10, 2020 meeting minutes and Dave seconded.

Mr. Ormeroid presented the Board of Trustees with information concerning House Bill 163, which is the 2020 Clean Water Act. Specifically, House Bill 163 allows Townships to have access to municipal water and sewer and prohibits municipalities from denying utility services to neighboring unincorporated entities. Dan moved for the Board of Trustees to consider a Resolution supporting House Bill 163 and Dave seconded. All ayes.

Ms. Way-Young provided the Board of Trustees with the 2020 DGHD car seat and booster inspection schedule. In addition, Ms. Way-Young reported on the present Coronavirus outbreak and the precautionary steps the health district is incorporating to educate the public.

Todd reported that five (5) culverts had been repaired by Miley Excavating on River Road between State Route 37 and Byers Road. Weather permitting; Miley Excavating will proceed with culvert replacement north of Byers Road this week.

Todd advised the Board of Trustees that new signage was required in the cemetery prohibiting artificial flowers April 1st to November 1st.

Dave reported that the Heritage Society building sustained damage due to a motor vehicle accident on Sunday, February 23. Primarily most of the damage was confined to the front door of the building. The Township will be notified by the at fault motorists insurance company regarding coverage of the damages.


Dave presented the Board of Trustees with information from the Delaware County Prosecutor regarding elected official health insurance reimbursement. Additional information from the Township is to be provided to Mr. Eric Penkal in the Prosecutor's Office prior to further action.


Dan stated that the next meeting of the Delaware County Township Association would be Thursday, March 5 at 6:00 PM at the Barn at Stratford.


Dan presented the Board of Trustees with the final draft of the upcoming inaugural Township newsletter.
