Minutes of the Radnor Township Board of Trustees

January 27, 2020

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The Radnor Township Board of Trustees met on Monday, January 27, 2020 at 7:00 PM at the Radnor Community Center.

Those present were: Teresa Watkins, Dave Weber, Dan Boysel, Marlboro Township Trustee Hal Clase, Doug Riedel from the Delaware County Engineers Office, Jenifer Way-Young from the Delaware General Health District, Randy Butts, Katarina Wheeland, Todd Coonfare and John Coonfare.

Teresa called the meeting to order and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Minutes of the January 13, 2020 meeting were read. Dan moved to approve the January 13, 2020 meeting minutes and Dave seconded.

Ms. Way-Young provided the Board of Trustees with the 2020 Delaware General Health District Special Events Collection Calendar.

Mr. Clase advised the Board of Trustees that Marlboro Township has applied for an Ohio Public Works Commission Issue II Grant for road surface improvements to North Section Line Road from the Marion County line to just north of Peel Road. Improvements would include widening the road by two (2) feet on the Radnor Township portion of the road. Based on the recommended surface improvement by the Delaware County Engineer, Radnor Township's portion in the total project would be \$78,415.00. Due to the uncertainty associated with the Townships own OPWC Issue II Grant Application for River Road, the Board of Trustees discussed the appropriate funding available for North Section Line Road. In addition, River Road culvert replacement costs were determined to be \$16,150.00 for three (3) culverts. If all culverts were replaced on the OPWC Issue II funded portion of River Road, the total cost would be approximately \$70,000.00. Given the expenses associated with River Road improvements and culvert replacement, Dan moved to cap expenses related to North Section Line Road at \$63,000.00 and Dave seconded. All ayes. Dave will consult with Miley Excavating on River Road culvert replacement and determine what repairs can be attained for a maximum of \$45,000.00.

Todd advised the Board of Trustees that Bauerle Automotive estimated the cost for a new turbocharger for the International truck to be \$3,100.00. The Board of Trustees discussed the possibility of replacing the International truck in the near future. The approximate life span of a turbocharger is three (3) years and due to the need for the truck in the winter weather season, Dave moved to repair the International truck for \$3,100.00 and Dan seconded. All ayes.


Dave reported that his roof repair contact was not able to schedule the required metal roof repairs at the Historical Building. Teresa stated that she would contact a metal roof repair firm and attempt to have the necessary repairs completed.

Dan provided the Board of Trustees with plans from resident Jim Rodman for the construction of a new 48' by 15' grain bin on his property located at 5530 Radnor Road. Dave moved to approve the construction of the new grain bin on Mr. Rodman's property at 5530 Radnor Road and Dan seconded. All ayes.


Teresa advised the Board of Trustees of the need to proceed with improvements to the park. Specifically noted were improving the area near the recycle bins and addressing the questions associated with the access drives to the park.

The Board of Trustees signed the 2019 Ohio Department of Transportation Township Highway Mileage Certification.

There being no further business, Dave moved to adjourn and Dan seconded.
