The Radnor Township Board of Trustees met on Monday, November 23, 2020 at 7:00 PM at the Radnor Community Center.

Those present were: Teresa Watkins, Dave Weber, Dan Boysel, Randy Butts, Radnor Township resident Dan Buck, and Katarina Wheeland.

Teresa called the meeting to order and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Minutes of the October 26, 2020 meeting were read. Dan moved to approve the October 26, 2020 meeting minutes and Dave seconded.

Randy updated the Board of Trustees that the annual pay for the volunteer firefighters was given to the Fiscal Officer for processing. He also reported that both furnaces in the truck bay were not working and had been fixed.

Dan Buck, a Township resident residing on Hodges Road, requested assistance from the Board of Trustees regarding increased traffic and speeding on Hodges Road. The Board agreed to do a traffic study and see if it warrants a decrease in the speed limit. The Trustees filled out an REA form to submit to the Delaware County Engineer.

Dave reported to the Board of Trustees that he cleaned out 18 inches of debris from the Main Street drainage system and jetted the drain in order to help with the Historical Museum.

Dan notified the Board that he attended the first Delaware County Commissioner's Office zoom meeting for the vacation of the alleyway on Radnor Road; the second meeting will be held on December 7, 2020 via zoom.



Teresa also reported that the new air purifiers/humidifiers in the Historical Museum have been fixed and are working.


The Board of Trustees agreed to close the Radnor Township Community Center until further notice, as well as cancel all rentals for December. Dave moved to approve the closure, Dan seconded. Teresa opposed. Fiscal Officer will place an ad in the Delaware Gazette and on Township website.


