

# Record of Proceedings

## Minutes of the Radnor Township Board of Trustees

September 28, 2020

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The Radnor Township Board of Trustees met on Monday, September 28, 2020 at 7:00 PM at the Radnor Community Center.

Those present were: Teresa Watkins, Dave Weber, Dan Boysel, Doug Riedel from the Delaware County Engineer's Office, Todd Coonfare, Randy Butts, Joe Garrett from Trebel, and Katarina Wheeland.

Teresa called the meeting to order and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Minutes of the September 14, 2020 meeting were read. Dan moved to approve the September 14, 2020 meeting minutes and Teresa seconded.

Doug Riedel from the Delaware County Engineer's Office updated the Board of Trustees on the Ohio Public Works Commission (OPWC) grant applications for two projects in 2021. First, Doug provided the application for the joint project on Hills Miller Rd. with Troy Township. Fiscal Officer certified the necessary funds of \$7,000.00 and the Board signed the application for Doug to submit. Secondly, the Board of Trustees signed Resolution 05-20 authorizing Teresa Watkins to prepare and submit an application to participate in the OPWC State Capital Improvement and/or Local Transportation Improvement Program(s). Dan moved to appoint Teresa as the Authorized Township Representative and accept Resolution 05-20, Dave seconded, all ayes. The application was given to Doug to be submitted.

Doug advised the Board on installing a "No Engine Breaking" sign on S. Section Line Road at SR 37/SR 203, and on S. Section Line Road at Warrensburg Rd provided a sign isn't installed further south by a boarding township. Dave motioned to accept a Resolution authorizing the installment of "No Engine Breaking" signs, Dan seconded, all ayes. Resolution 06-20 was approved and a copy was given to Doug to be submitted.

Doug informed the Board of Trustees of a resolution needed to approve the vacation of the platted roadway located at 3238 Radnor Road. Dan moved to accept Resolution 07-20, Dave seconded, all ayes. Fiscal Officer will email a copy of the Resolution to the Delaware County Commissioner.

Additionally, Doug updated the Board on the culvert issue on Byers Road. Dave moved to include fixing the culvert to the road improvements occurring on Byers Road in 2021, Dan seconded.

Todd reported to the Board of Trustees that Timberland Tree Company preformed service at the cemetery on the trees that fell down. He also notified the Trustees that he purchased a new fuel pump for the Maintenance building. Lastly, Todd informed the Board that Miley Excavating repaired a broken extension pipe during culvert repair on River Road and they would be doing culvert repair on Curren Road in the near future during which the road will need to be closed for a day.

Randy notified the Trustees that there have been additional costs added to the newly order fire engine from Rosenbauer; they were costs that should have originally been included but were overlooked.

The Board of Trustees made the decision to reopen the Community Center for rentals beginning November 1, 2020 and instructed Randy to follow the current guidelines provided by the Delaware General Health District to ensure safety precautions are taken and social distancing is encouraged.

Joe Garrett, representing Trebel, advised the Board of Trustees about his company's aggregation program. The Trustees determined to take the offer for Trebel's assistance under consideration.

Dave reported on the progress to the Radnor Township Historical Society, mentioning that the work that has been done thus far has helped. Teresa added to the report that a company will be out to quote carpet removal and the dehumidifiers/air purifiers have an installation date in October.

Teresa provided a quote from Seller's Electric for \$8,500.00 to light the flag pole. Dan moved to accept the offer, on the condition that the work is done by November 15, 2020, Dave seconded.


The Board of Trustees discussed applying for funding provided to Radnor Township by the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act, as well as possible uses for the funds. Dan moved to accept Resolution 08-20 adopted to apply for funding for Radnor Township provided by the CARES Act, Dave seconded, all ayes.



The Board of Trustees discussed Trick-or-Treat in Radnor Township. The Board opted to hold Trick-or-Treat on Saturday, October 31, 2020 from 6:00PM to 8:00PM and agreed to post the safety guidelines provided by the Delaware General Health District on the Radnor Township website.


