## Minutes of the Radnor Township Board of Trustees

December 27, 2021

The Radnor Township Board of Trustees met on Monday, December 27, 2021 at 9:00 AM at the Radnor Community Center.

Those present were: Dan Boysel, Teresa Watkins, Jenifer Way-Young from the Delaware Public Health District, Doug Riedel from the Delaware County Engineer's Office, Bob Fish, Todd Coonfare, and Katarina Wheeland.

Dan called the meeting to order and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Minutes of the November 22, 2021 meeting were read. Teresa moved to approve the meeting minutes; Dan seconded.

Jenifer distributed the Delaware Public Health District's COVID-19 Monthly Report and discussed their partnership with Delaware County Libraries to hand out COVID-19 tests. She also updated the Board on DPHD's Christmas lights recycling program.

Doug update the Board the estimate for the county paving program was not received by December 17, 2021 so he does not have it to present to the Board, he stated he will be at the January meeting to discuss the estimate and plan for 2022 road improvements. Doug mentioned the public comment period for the US 23 study from ODOT has been extended through February 2022 and will include 2 more informational meetings.

Bob took the Board of Trustees on a tour of the new fire truck.

Todd reported the International Dump Truck sold for a little over \$15,000.00. He updated the Board that the F650 was undercoated and he is getting a quote put together for its PTO pump. He also the truck used for the cemetery was repaired and noted there were 21 burials in 2021 for the Radnor Township Cemetery.

Teresa informed the Board the Curtis Road project with FEMA has been approved. The house needs to be torn down, however, it was noted the cost will not be incurred by the township. Plans for the property will be for the Township to plow it and plant wild flowers.

Dan provided the Board with an estimate from Guider for \$1,700.00 to mark the Township's park boundaries and provide a plat to the Township. Dan moved to accept the quote, Teresa seconded. Dan mentioned he is seeking guidance in putting together a Personnel Policy for the Township. He also noted the Radnor Township Newsletter is now available on the Delaware County Township Association website.

Dan moved to have the Board of Trustees Organizational Meeting on Monday, January 10, 2022, Teresa seconded. After the Organizational Meeting, the Board will discuss regular Township business.




