## Minutes of the Radnor Township Board of Trustees

July 26, 2021

The Radnor Township Board of Trustees met on Monday, July 26, 2021 at 7:00 PM at the Radnor Community Center.

Those present were: Dave Weber, Dan Boysel, Teresa Watkins, Jennifer Way-Young from the Delaware Public Health District (DPHD), Doug Riedel from the Delaware County Engineer's Office, Bob Fish, Todd Coonfare, and Katarina Wheeland.

Dave called the meeting to order and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Minutes of the June 28, 2021 meeting were read. Teresa moved to approve the June 228, 2021 meeting minutes and Dave seconded.

Jennifer notified the Board of Trustees that the DPHD has their School Supplies for Scholars event coming up, as well as a vaccine clinic for students entering 7<sup>th</sup> grade. She also handed out flyers regarding child passenger safety and the DPHD Benefit in the Barn, which will be held on August 14<sup>th</sup> and benefits hunger relief in Delaware County.

Doug provided the Board with a contract for River Road from OPWC for the Trustees to sign. Work for the project has yet to be scheduled. The joint project for Hills Miller has the same status as Troy Township signed their contract the previous week. The Trustees discussed going on a road tour with Doug to plan for 2022; the date is set for Monday August 18<sup>th</sup> at 10:00 AM. Finally, Doug reported that OPWC has gone to a web-based portal moving forward for applications and signatures.

Bob shared photos of the new fire truck with the Board of Trustees and reported the project is moving along nicely.

Todd reported that River Rd. culvert installation was completed by Miley Excavating, as well as some catch basins. He also updated the Board on the status of the road mower and where he is on purchasing a new one.

Dan notified the Board that he was contacted by the Delaware County Library regarding the possibility of installing a book locker in our Township, likely located at the Community Center. The library will pay to install the locker and have electric run to it using a grant. Dan also suggested the Trustees being thinking about how the Township can utilize the ARAP funding, including having fiber fun to the Community Center from the Delaware County EMS station.

Teresa informed the Trustees that Ann Jones, president of the Radnor Township Historical Society, has been thinking of several improvements they would like to do to the Historical Museum. Their current status of the projects is compiling a list and collecting estimates. Teresa also mentioned that FEMA has contacted her regarding the Flood Level along River Rd.; they want to increase the level from 9 feet to 12 feet. Todd advised against this change as River Rd. is impacted when the flood level is at 9 feet.

Dave updated the Board on the status of the salt barn for the Maintenance Building. He is hopeful to have quotes for the project soon.

The Board of Trustees signed the June 2021 Bank Reconciliation.

The next Board of Trustees meeting will be Monday, August 23, 2021 at 7:00PM at the Radnor Township Community Center located at 4061 State Route 203.


There being no further business, Teresa moved to adjourn and Dave seconded.




