The Radnor Township Board of Trustees met on Monday, March 22, 2021 at 7:00 PM at the Radnor Community Center.

Those present were: Dave Weber, Dan Boysel, Teresa Watkins, Todd Coonfare, Randy Butts, and Katarina Wheeland.

Dave called the meeting to order and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Minutes of the February 22, 2021 meeting were read. Dan moved to approve the February 22, 2021 meeting minutes and Teresa seconded.

Todd reported to the Board of Trustees he purchased flags for the township and fire department and plans to purchase Radnor Township flags at TSC.

Todd also notified the Board that the maintenance department recently applied cold patch to the roads, mostly on River Road.

Randy notified the Board of Trustees of an email he received from the Delaware County EMA office regarding CARES Act money being extended until the end of 2021 and stated the fire department has many needs that could qualify.

Randy also reported to the Board that he has received two quotes for miscellaneous equipment on the new truck. He requested permission from the Board to purchase said equipment in two or three orders. Dan motion to accept Randy's proposal, Teresa seconded.

Finally, Randy updated the Board of Trustees on the fire department's Memorial Day plans. The fire department would like to hold the parade at 10:00 AM as it has been in the past. Then plans on hosting their annual Hog Roast at the station in a drive-thru format.

Continuing the discussion regarding Memorial Day, Teresa notified the Board of Trustees that she is organizing the cemetery ceremony for after the parade.

Teresa reported that the Historical Society has requested a fire alarm system that rings directly to the fire department set up in the museum; she will look into a monitoring system.

Teresa initiated a discussion about ideas to improve the township including putting up a fence around the recycling bins, moving the drive to the park this summer and getting a barrier on the north side of the property, as well as getting an estimate to re-landscape the Township Community Center. Teresa will get a quote for the fence. Dave volunteered to do the landscaping and the township can pay wholesale for the materials.

Dan updated the Board on the conflict between a Radnor Township resident and a Thompson Township resident involving a barking dog complaint. No progress has been made to date; Dan is reaching out the Thompson Township Board of Trustees for help finding a resolution.

Dan notified the Board of a complaint regarding River Road paving and three large trees that need dealt with.

Dave reported to the Board of Trustees that the OPWC Bid Packet for the 2021 Road Improvements Project is set. The Trustees signed the paving estimate and authorized the placement of an ad in the Delaware Gazette inviting contractors to bid for the project.

Dave informed the Board that he and Todd met with Bruce Miley to get an estimate for tile repair.

Additionally, Dave request the Board look into getting updated rules/regulations for the Radnor Cemetery,

The Board of Trustees signed the February 2021 bank reconciliation.


The Board of Trustees signed the mileage for the Delaware County EMA.

There being no further business, Teresa moved to adjourn and Dan seconded.




