Minutes of the Radnor Township Board of Trustees

The Radnor Township Board of Trustees met on Monday, May 24, 2021 at 7:00 PM at the Radnor Community Center.

Those present were: Dave Weber, Dan Boysel, Teresa Watkins, Randy Butts, Todd Coonfare, and Katarina Wheeland.

Dave called the meeting to order and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Minutes of the April 26, 2021 meeting were read. Teresa moved to approve the April 26, 2021 meeting minutes and Dan seconded.

Randy reported to the Board the fire department would definitely make use of any COVID-19 money given to the township if/when it becomes available. He also stated for the past month and a half, all the trucks have been out of service at some point but all are up and running currently. Additionally, Randy notified the Board that the carpet in the Township Community Room would be cleaned the following Thursday.

On the topic of the Community Room, Teresa moved to open the Township Community Center and begin to allow rentals again beginning June 2, 2021. Dan seconded, all ayes. It was mentioned the price would still be \$50.00 to rent per day and the notice will be added to the Township's website.

Todd reported to the Board of Trustees Bruce Miley will do the culvert repairs on Byers Road within the next two weeks, before the county patches the road. The road will likely be closed for a day or two, and notice will need to be given to the fire department as well as an ad placed in the Delaware Gazette.

Todd also notified the Board that he has been having issues with the road mower and has replaced parts for it but has not made it down to get a quote for a new road mower. Additionally, Todd mentioned he repaired the cemetery lychgate and they will be rehung before Memorial Day.

Teresa notified the Board she has received many calls regarding the "Blasting Area" signs. She called the company and they explained the signs were put up to notify residents it is a blasting area, however, they do not plan on making the area into a working quarry anytime soon. Teresa also spoke to the Delaware County Health Department to inquire about a third pick up day for the bins. The health department looked into the issues and Teresa was told our recycling bins to not warrant another pickup at this time.

Dan informed the Board he is looking into getting fiber run to the Township building since Verizon is working on the tower and Consolidated is running fiber to the EMS station at some point. This would help with the issues the Fire Department and Fiscal Officer have been running into regarding slow internet speeds,


Dave provided the Board with an estimate from No Dig Construction for \$10,010.60 for a road sleeve on River Road. Dan moved to accept the estimate and move forward, Teresa seconded. All ayes.

Additionally, Dave informed the Board the and Todd met with the Dexter Company to look at a 2021 Freightliner Snow Plow Truck. The truck is \$146,500.00 and we can finance through them. Dan moved to accept the bid and move ahead with financing, Teresa seconded. All ayes.

The Board of Trustees signed the April 2021 bank reconciliation, as well as the 2021 Radnor Township Road Improvements Contract with the Shelly Company and the IPA contract for the 2019 and 2020 audit.

The next Board of Trustees meeting will be Monday, June 28, 2021 at 7:00PM at the Radnor Township Community Center located at 4061 State Route 203.

There being no further business, Teresa moved to adjourn and Dan seconded.




