Minutes of the Radnor Township Board of Trustees

October 25, 2021

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The Radnor Township Board of Trustees met on Monday, October 25, 2021 at 7:00 PM at the Radnor Community Center.

Those present were: Dave Weber, Dan Boysel, Teresa Watkins, Chris Roshon, Natural Resources Manager for Delaware County Preservation Parks, Jennifer Way-Young from the Delaware Public Health District, Doug Riedel from the Delaware County Engineer's Office, Randy Butts, Todd Coonfare, and Katarina Wheeland.

Dave called the meeting to order and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Minutes of the September 27, 2021 meeting were read. Teresa moved to approve the September 27, 2021 meeting minutes and Dan seconded.

Chris shared a presentation to the Board in regards to the levy that Preservation Parks has on the November ballot. With levy monies, the park district plans to increase their land acquisition and development of several future parks. This levy would be in addition to the current levy which can be used for land purchases as well as wages and programs the parks provide.

Jennifer informed the Board the DPHD picked up 500 pounds of trash during their River Clean-Up event. She also provided the Board with a Flu and COVID Vaccine Clinic flyer and a Recycle Right Holiday String Lights flyer.

Doug notified the Board the road work for Hills Miller Rd. and River Rd. are completed; however, striping date for our three roads is still to be determined. Doug also alerted the Board of the November 19th deadline to submit our plan for the County Paving Program. The Trustees determined a Special Meeting will be held on Monday, November 08, 2021 at 6:00 PM at the Radnor Township Community Center to discuss their plans for road improvement projects in 2022.

Randy informed the Board the turnout gear washer/dryer has been purchased and delivered. He also reported the new fire engine is ready and final inspection is completed. The next step in the process will be transporting the truck to Ohio where Rosenbauer will do another final inspection before delivering it to Radnor Township Fire Department.

Todd reported new road mower is on order; it is due in late February/early March. He also stated there is no longer a need for the old International truck and the Board determined to list it on govdeals.com to sell.

Dan updated the Board that the Township Newsletter was sent to publisher. He also stated he requested information from Clint Matlack regarding zoning for the salt bin.

Teresa notified the Board the next Radnor Township Park Committee meeting will be on Monday, November 08, 2021 at 7:00 PM at the Radnor Township Community Center.

Dave informed the Board the new doors for the Maintenance Building have been ordered, estimated delivery is in 12 weeks. He stated there is a ten year lease program available through Richwood Bank to finance the projects for the Maintenance Building.

The Board of Trustees discussed the situation of a citizen requesting to set up a Cemetery Bequest through a donation to Radnor Township that would require the Township to be responsible for providing flowers annually, as well as, clean the gravesite. The Board determined that Bequests are not something the Township is able to uphold and accepting money to do so is something the Township is not willing to set precedence for.


The Board of Trustees signed the September 2021 Bank Reconciliation.

There being no further business, Teresa moved to adjourn and Dan seconded.




