## Minutes of the Radnor Township Board of Trustees

June 13, 2022

The Radnor Township Board of Trustees met on Monday, June 13, 2022 at 6:30 PM at the Radnor Community Center.

Roll Call was taken as follows: Dan Boysel, aye; Dave Weber, aye; Teresa Watkins, aye. Also attending: Ken Fryman, Scott Stephens (Delaware SWCD), Doug Riedel (DCEO), Todd Coonfare, and Katarina Wheeland.

Dan called the meeting to order and Teresa led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Teresa motioned to approve the May 23, 2022 meeting minutes as written; Dave seconded the motion. All ayes, motion carries 3-0.

Ken Fryman, representing Pride in Radnor, proposed a historical marker for Radnor Township/Village, paid for by Pride in Radnor, to be located near the flagpole at the cemetery. Teresa moved to approve the site for the historical marker; Dave seconded. All ayes, motion carries 3-0.

Scott Stephens from Delaware County Soil & Water Conservation discussed options for the Griffith drainage ditch that backs up. He stated the process would start with an informational meeting for Township residents effected by the drainage ditch. The Trustees opted to handle the drainage issue in house for now and will revisit assistance from Soil & Water as a backup plan if needed.

Doug notified the Board that Township roadwork will begin in the next week or so.


Todd updated the Board on the Maintenance Department; stating the new road mower will be delivered soon, there was maintenance work done on the Freightliner, and the Township will likely need a new zero turn mower which is estimated to cost \$13,000.00.

The Board spoke of the recent Memorial Day township celebration/ceremony; mentioning the keynote speaker did a great job and they were very pleased with the beautification to the Township Cemetery and the Fire Departments Hog Roast.

The Board was presented with the Payment Listing and the Fund Status as of June 13, 2022. Teresa motioned to approve the Payment Register for June 1-13, 2022, Dave seconded; all ayes, motion carries 3-0.

The Board signed the May 2022 Bank Reconciliation.

There being no further business, Teresa moved to adjourn and Dave seconded; all ayes, motion carries 3-0. The next regularly scheduled Board of Trustees meeting will be held on Monday, June 27, 2022 at 7:00PM.




