The Radnor Township Board of Trustees met on Monday, November 14, 2022 at 6:30 PM at the Radnor Community Center.

Roll Call was taken as follows: Dan Boysel, aye; Dave Weber, aye; Teresa Watkins, aye. Also in attendance Bob Fish and Katarina Wheeland.

Dan called the meeting to order and Teresa led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Dan motioned to approve the October ²⁴~~10~~, 2022 meeting minutes as written, Teresa seconded. All ayes, motion carries 3-0.

Assistant Chief Fish updated the Board regarding the fire department and provided them with a list of employees yet to fulfil the background check requirements. Additionally, Bob stated he spoke to a representative from the Ohio Fire Marshall's Office regarding missing reports dating back to March 2022.

The Board determined an Executive Session meeting will be needed prior to the next regularly scheduled monthly meeting in order for the Board to discuss Fire Department personnel and issues within the Fire Department. The Executive Session meeting will be held at 6:30 PM on Monday, November 28, 2022; the Board plans to invite Chief Randy Butts to the meeting. Dan also stated he will contact the Delaware County Prosecutor's Office for assistance in the matter.

Trustee Weber shared Todd Coonfare's update regarding the Maintenance Department; primarily discussing selling old mowers. The Board decided to table the discussion on selling verse keeping the mowers until Mr. Coonfare was in attendance to provide clarification. However, Trustee Watkins motioned to allow Mr. ~~Jeff Liggett~~ ^{Brad Williamson} to purchase a mower from the Township at the priced based on the quote received, Trustee Weber seconded. All ayes, motion carries 3-0.

Trustee Watkins stated she is meeting on Thursday, November 17, 2022 at the Welsh Museum with Sellers Electric to discuss installing lighting once the drop ceiling is removed and would also like to receive a quote from Sellers for the Township Community Center's kitchen vent hood. Finally, Ms. Watkins updated the Board on the final invoice for the replacement plaque at the Township Ballfield; the Township will be responsible for \$500.00, the Ashley Legion will be responsible for \$500.00, and Mr. Ken Fryman will be donating the remaining \$733.00.

Trustee Boysel notified the Board the deadline to put the Fire Levy on the ballot in the spring of 2023 is February 2, 2023.

The Board was presented with the Payment Listing and the Fund Status as of November 14, 2022. Teresa motioned to approve the Payment Register for November 1-14, 2022, Dave seconded; all ayes, motion carries 3-0.

The Board signed the October 2022 Bank Reconciliation.

Fiscal Officer Wheeland signed the Bureau of Workers' Compensation Schedule of Audit Findings.


Trustee Weber signed the Radnor Township 2022 Paving Program Approval and Acceptance Form.

Trustee Watkins signed a letting to Mr. and Mrs. Ramsey regarding the appraisal of their property and the price the Delaware County EMA is offering the homeowners.


