Minutes of the Radnor Township Board of Trustees

October 24 2022

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The Radnor Township Board of Trustees met on Monday, October 24, 2022 at 7:00 PM at the Radnor Community Center.

Roll Call was taken as follows: Dan Boysel, aye; Dave Weber, aye; Teresa Watkins, aye. Also in attendance Michael Cavanaugh, Jenifer Way-Young, Bob Fish and Katarina Wheeland.

Dan called the meeting to order and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Dan motioned to approve the October 10, 2022 meeting minutes as written. All ayes, motion carries 3-0.

Mr. Cavanaugh, from the Delaware County Prosecutor's Office, introduced himself to the Board. Mr. Cavanaugh is the new Assistant Prosecuting Attorney representing Radnor Township.

Ms. Way-Young, from the Delaware Public Health District, distributed fliers for the DPHD clinic schedule for COVID-19 Vaccine and Flu Vaccine, as well as information for home health visits.

Assistant Chief Fish notified the Board the new truck bay furnace is working properly. Assistant Chief Fish mentioned the fire department is trying to interview in order to daily staff a third person, but is having scheduling conflicts with Chief Butts. Dave motioned to have Asst. Chief Fish solely conduct interviews in order to get the hiring process moving and approved Bob to hire three to six part time staff members. Teresa seconded the motion. All ayes, motion carries 3-0. Additionally, Asst. Chief Fish stated the deadline for background checks is quickly approaching; the Board and Bob requested an updated list of completed background checks be emailed to them.

Trustee Weber updated the Board he has not received the report for the accident on Penry Road from the State Patrol, nor has he heard news regarding the Salt Barn project start date. Dave mentioned the No Dig estimate was resent to the contractor verifying the tile is 18 inches and the work will be completed in 2023.

Trustee Watkins stated she acquiring quotes for carpet installation in the Township Community Center main room and Fiscal Officer's office and vinyl flooring in the kitchen and bathrooms, as well as updating the kitchen cabinets, countertop, and appliances. Teresa also would like to have the other half of the windows in the community center replaced.

Trustee Boysel corrected the date for the Solar Meeting as Wednesday, November 16, 2022 which was incorrect in the Township Newsletter. Dan stated he would spread the word of the correct date via Facebook and a notice on the Board outside of the Township Community Center. Trustee Boysel also notified the Board the Township should receive an estimate from the Delaware County Engineer's Office for 2023 based on the Road Tour.






The Board signed the September 2022 Bank Reconciliation.
