Minutes of the Radnor Township Board of Trustees

September 25, 2023

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The Radnor Township Board of Trustees met on Monday, September 25, 2023 at 6:30 PM at the Radnor Community Center.

Trustee Watkins called the meeting to order and Trustee Boysel led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call was taken as follows: Teresa Watkins, aye; Dave Weber, aye; Dan Boysel, aye. Also present, RTFD Assistant Chief Bob Fish, RTFD employees Brad Belville and Dorian Ross, Jenifer Way-Young from the Delaware Public Health District, Doug Riedel from the Delaware County Engineer's Office, Todd Coonfarth and Katarina Wheeland.

Trustee Weber motioned to approve the September 11, 2023 meeting minutes; Trustee Boysel seconded. All ayes; motion carries 3-0.

Ms Way-Young provided the Board with fliers from the Health District pertaining to the Fall into Health event, 16 AHA/CPR training, and information regarding their levy on the November ballot.

Mr. Riedel updated the Board on roadwork for N. Sectionline Rd. and the application for Buttermilk Hill Rd. Additionally, he notified the Board Old Roberts Rd. may not be able to be vacated; however, the Township may need to put up a "Dead End" or "No Outlet" sign instead.

Asst. Chief Fish stated Engine 431 is out of service.

The Fire Dept. provided the Board with a run update for August 2023.

Mr. Coonfarth updated the Board the John Deere tractor is fixed, signs for the stop signs at the Penry Rd. and N. Sectionline Rd. intersection had been installed, and the maintenance department is working on trimming trees throughout the Township, especially with concern to the roadways.

Trustee Weber described the trash cans at the fire station will be replaced with a dumpster provided by the new trash company on October 1, 2023. He stated the concrete will be poured next week at the salt barn and is receiving a quote for insulation and metal on the sides and roof of the structure. Dave mentioned the corn at the intersection of Veel Rd. and N. Sectionline is not within the Township's jurisdiction and therefore was not cut down. He stated the OPA has training so that Todd can earn a commercial spraying license. Trustee Weber provided the Board with a sketch of the proposed changes to the maintenance building. Trustee Boysel motioned to approve the work; Trustee Weber seconded; all ayes; motion carries 3-0.


The Board discussed selling the old veterinary truck and determined to place an advertisement in the Township Newsletter, along with a photograph of the vehicle, asking sealed bids be received by November 25, 2023.

Trustee Boysel updated the Board on the Township Newsletter, which printing of has recently switched to Mail Pro One, and any information to be included in the newsletter should sent to him by October 15, 2023.

Trustee Watkins notified the Board the Curtis Rd. property closed and she provided the Fiscal Officer with a check to cover the cost of taxes that will be due, along with a set of keys for FO and the fire department. She stated the new appliances for the kitchen in the community room were received and installed. Additionally, Teresa was granted permission from the Board to purchase a carpet cleaner for the community room in order to stay on top of stains to the new carpet.

The Board was presented with the Payment Listing, Receipt Detail, and the Fund Status as of September 25, 2023. Trustee Boysel motioned to approve the Payment Register for September 12-25, 2023, Trustee Weber seconded; all ayes, motion carries 3-0.

There being no further business, Trustee Weber moved to adjourn and Trustee Boysel seconded; all ayes, motion carries 3-0. The next regularly scheduled Board of Trustees meeting will be held on Monday, September 25, 2023 at 6:30 PM.
