Minutes of the Radnor Township Board of Trustees

September 9, 2024

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The Radnor Township Board of Trustees met on Monday, September 9, 2024 at 6:30 PM at the Radnor Community Center.

Trustee Boysel called the meeting to order and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call was taken as follows: Dan Boysel, aye, Dave Weber, aye, Cameron James, aye. Also present: Katarina Wheeland and RTFD employees Bob Fish, Shawn Kelly, Dorian Ross, and Greg Butts.

Trustee Weber motioned to approve the August 26, 2024 meeting; Trustee Boysel seconded. All ayes, motion carries 3-0.

Trustee Boysel motioned to go into executive session to discuss the purchase and/or sale of property; Trustee Weber seconded; all ayes, motion carries 3-0. Roll call taken as follows: Dan Boysel, aye, Dave Weber, aye, Cameron James, aye. The Board resumed their regular, open meeting at 6:38 PM. No further action was taken.

Fire Department Report:

The fire department proposed the Township purchase tool boxes for Firefighter Long's truck to store tools in order to perform maintenance to department vehicles as Firefighter Long is a certified to repair the trucks. The Board discussed and decided purchasing tools to be stored on location would better suite the Township.

A salesman from All American has an interested buyer for Engine 431; Chief Fish will speak to Michael Cavanaugh regarding selling the truck as is to another fire department.

Trustees Report:

Trustee James reported the noxious weed issue on N. Sectionline Rd has not been remedied; he plans on calling the land owner to settle the issue.

Trustee Weber obtained a general quote for \$10,000.00 to \$12,000.00 from the Dexter Company for Freightliner maintenance truck to assist with berm work; the Board tabled the discussion for now as a hot water power washer is a higher need for the maintenance department.

Trustee Boysel stated Consolidated Co-op is looking to donate 1-2 trees to Radnor Township; Trustee Weber suggested the Maintenance Building. Ann Jones asked Trustee Boysel if the Township would like to purchase a Radnor Flag for the community room; the Board approved the purchase.

Trustee Boysel notified the Board that Jeremy Froehlich, assistant superintendent for Buckeye Valley Local Schools, requested holding a BVLS Bond Levy Meeting in October; the Board opted to have the meeting immediately before their regular meeting.


Fiscal Officer Report:




