Minutes of the Radnor Township Board of Trustees

August 26, 2019

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The Radnor Township Board of Trustees met on Monday, August 26, 2019 at 7:00 PM at the Radnor Community Center.

Those present were Dan Boysel, Teresa Watkins, Dave Weber, Jennifer Way-Young from the Delaware General Health District, Delaware County Prosecutor Melissa Schiffel, Donna Meyer, Bob Fish, Todd Coonfare and John Coonfare.

Dan called the meeting to order and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Minutes of the August 12, 2019 meeting were read. Dave moved to approve the August 12, 2019 meeting minutes and Teresa seconded.

Ms. Way-Young advised the Board of Trustees that the DGHD would be offering onsite influenza prevention clinics in the coming months. Dates and times are dependent on staff availability and any clinic provided at the Community Center would require coordination with Randy.

Ms. Way-Young provided the Board of Trustees with information from the DGHD on the Township's community profile.

Ms. Meyer advised the Board of Trustees of her willingness to be involved in planning activities for future improvements to the park. She stated that she has experience in grant writing and expressed her desire to assist in that aspect or any other ways needed.

Todd provided the Board of Trustees with cost estimates from Parrott Implement for a new John Deere Z930 R mower. Depending on the tires that are installed the mower would be either \$10,717.00 or \$11,377.00. Further research on the tires is required and an onsite demonstration is desired.

Dave reported that Wells Septic and Drain Cleaning would be doing the required culvert tile cleaning in the next several weeks on Buttermilk Hill Road but he did not have an update from Small's Asphalt Paving or Sellers Electric on their project start dates.

The Board of Trustees discussed the information to be included on the fact sheet that will be provided voters regarding the 2.9 mill five (5) year road levy. It was determined that two (2) mailers should be done and the period for both mailers was discussed.


Dan reported that the Delaware County Township Association would be meeting on Saturday, October 12, 2019 from 10:00 AM to 12:00 PM.

The Board of Trustees were presented with the final cost breakdown for the Ohio Public Works Commission Grant Application for improvements to River Road. The total cost to the Township will be \$25,916.00. In addition, the Certificate of Local Funds as well as the Cooperative Project Agreement By And Between Radnor Township And Delaware County were signed.

There being no further business, Dave moved to adjourn and Dan seconded.
