Minutes of the Radnor Township Board of Trustees

November 25, 2019

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The Radnor Township Board of Trustees met on Monday, November 25, 2019 at 7:00 PM at the Radnor Community Center.

Those present were Dan Boysel, Teresa Watkins, Dave Weber, Randy Butts, Todd Coonfare and John Coonfare.

Dan called the meeting to order and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Minutes of the November 11, 2019 meeting were read. Dave moved to approve the November 11, 2019 meeting minutes and Teresa seconded.

Randy presented the Board of Trustees with two (2) firefighters to be approved to join the department. One (1) of the applicants still needs to complete fire school training and Randy requested that the Township reimburse the applicant for the cost of the training. Dave moved to approve the two (2) firefighter applicants and to reimburse the cost of fire school training for one (1) of the applicants. Teresa seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.

Randy advised the Board of Trustees that the department was being reimbursed for costs associated with a fire run that involved a truck fire on U.S. 23 North in Marlboro Township on September 15.

The Board of Trustees reviewed the proposal from Parrott Implement for the new John Deere mowers. Todd stated that the tweels feature on the mowers would eliminate downtime due to tire issues with the mowers. Based on the age and hours of the mowers currently in service the Board of Trustees discussed purchasing two (2) mowers. Dave moved to purchase a 54" John Deere mower for \$11,377.15 and a 60" John Deere mower for \$12,570.62. Dan seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.

Todd reported that the John Deere tractor used for road mowing was in need of new front tires.


Dave requested that the Board of Trustees review the Township's policy on health care insurance reimbursement at the reorganization meeting in January.

Teresa presented information to the Board of Trustees on methods the Township can utilize to obtain funds for road repairs prior to receiving the initial disbursement of levy funds in March 2021. The Ohio Public Works Commission provides interest free loans that would be paid back with levy proceeds. However, the application is not due until July and the loan would not be approved until October 2020. The funds thru this process would not be received until FY 2021. The other funding option is an advance thru Delaware County and would involve securing bonds from a third party to borrow against future levy revenues. At this time, the Board of Trustees will not act on either of these revenue-generating options.


Dan provided the Board of Trustees with an overview of the Public Officials Training he attended sponsored by the Delaware County Prosecutor.

The Board of Trustees were presented with the Certificate of Result of Election from the Delaware County Board of Elections for the 2.9 mil five (5) year road levy.


There being no further business, Dave moved to adjourn and Teresa seconded.
