Minutes of the Radnor Township Board of Trustees

October 28, 2019

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The Radnor Township Board of Trustees met on Monday, October 28, 2019 at 7:00 PM at the Radnor Community Center.

Those present were Dan Boysel, Teresa Watkins, Dave Weber, Jennifer Way-Young from the Delaware General Health District, Doug Riedel from the Delaware County Engineer's office, Roy Plymale, Bob Fish, Todd Coonfare and John Coonfare.

Dan called the meeting to order and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Minutes of the October 7, 2019 meeting were read. Teresa moved to approve the October 7, 2019 meeting minutes and Dave seconded.

Ms. Way-Young advised the Board of Trustees that the DGHD would be providing residents the opportunity to recycle their Christmas string lights from November 29, 2019 to January 2, 2020 at selected locations throughout Delaware County.

Mr. Plymale reported that there were obsolete township records at the historical museum that should be removed. In addition, the Board of Trustees discussed the status and appropriate future action to take on the old fire truck currently in offsite storage.

Bob reported that the door openers for the fire bay doors were not operating correctly. Based on the recent repairs completed, general maintenance on all of the doors and openers is planned. Due to the critical nature of the doors operating accordingly, Dave moved to proceed with any fire bay door repairs and maintenance that are required and Teresa seconded.

Mr. Riedel provided the Board of Trustees with the updated sign requirements for Hills-Miller Road. Six (6) new signs are needed, three (3) in Troy Township and three (3) in Radnor Township. Once the specifications for the necessary posts are determined, the signs will be ready for installation.

Mr. Riedel reported that the grading and excavation work in conjunction with Troy Township at Buttermilk Hill Road and North Section Line Road would be completed next week weather permitting.

Mr. Riedel advised the Board of Trustees on the results of the three (3) Request for Engineering Assistance for Jones Road, Gallant Road and River Road. Only the River Road drainage issue will

be addressed at this time. Dave moved to proceed with the installation of a culvert on River Road .30 North of Dildine Road and Teresa seconded. Mr. Riedel estimated the new culvert would cost between \$2,500.00 and \$3,500.00.

Todd stated that Sellers Electric had installed the new fuel tanks at the maintenance building.

Todd advised the Board of Trustees that Parrott Implement had demonstrated the new John Deere mower available with tweels at the cemetery last week. Based on the cemetery and park mowing requirements, Todd will obtain current pricing for both 54" and 60" cutting widths.

Teresa reported that a barrier fence on the north property line of the park would cost approximately \$23,000.00 to \$26,000.00.


Dan stated that the library share a book box had been installed at the shelter house in the park.
