Minutes of the Radnor Township Board of Trustees

The Radnor Township Board of Trustees met on Monday, September 9, 2019 at 7:00 PM at the Radnor Community Center.

Those present were Dan Boysel, Teresa Watkins, Dave Weber, Sheila Hiddleson from the Delaware General Health District, Dave Kessler, Randy Butts, Bob Fish, Mike Foreman, Todd Coonfare and John Coonfare.

Dan called the meeting to order and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Minutes of the August 26, 2019 meeting were read. Teresa moved to approve the August 26, 2019 meeting minutes and Dave seconded.

Ms. Hiddleson provided the Board of Trustees with an update on activities at the DGHD. She reported that Mosquito trapping would conclude soon and that Measles immunization continued to be a priority. Randy will coordinate a schedule for the onsite influenza clinic at the Community Center.

Mr. Kessler advised the Board of Trustees that the appearance of the flagpole at the park was improved once the painting was complete. In addition, Mr. Kessler advised the Board of Trustees of his willingness to be involved with any park improvement planning.

Mike reported that the lighting in the Community Center bathrooms was not operating properly. Amstutz & Hedges Electric will be contacted for the necessary repairs and the possible conversion to LED lighting.

Todd stated that Parrott Implement would be providing an onsite demonstration of the John Deere Z930 R mower in the next several weeks.

Todd advised the Board of Trustees that the International Truck would be going to Bauerle Automotive in the next several weeks for pre-season maintenance prior to the upcoming winter weather season.

The Board of Trustees were advised that Kevin Larcom had expressed interest in doing part-time maintenance work for the Township. Based on his mechanical skills and possible possession of a Commercial Driver's License, Dave moved to hire Kevin Larcom as a part-time maintenance employee and Teresa seconded. All ayes.

Dave reported that he had been advised by a resident that tree roots were clogging a tile near Taylor Street and Main Street. The resident has offered to remove the tree but based on the location of the tree, the Board of Trustees discussed paying part of the cost for tree removal. Dave moved to split the cost for the removal of the tree at Taylor Street and Main Street and Teresa seconded. All ayes.

Teresa provided the Board of Trustees with a cost estimate from Tom Dew Excavating, Inc. for grading and seeding in the area of North Section Line Road and Buttermilk Hill Road. The project is in conjunction with Troy Township to complete the recent culvert tile improvements in the area. The cost for the required grading and seeding would be \$4,725.60. Dave moved to have Tom Dew Excavating, Inc. proceed with the work for \$4,725.60 in conjunction with Troy Township and Teresa seconded. All ayes.

Dan stated that the Delaware County Public Library desired to install a library box in the park that would be attached to the existing shelter house.


The Board of Trustees reviewed the fact sheet for the upcoming 2.9 mil five (5) year road levy.

The Board of Trustees completed a Request for Engineering Assistance for the Delaware County Engineer for culvert repairs on Curren Road and Jones Road.

The Board of Trustees were presented with Resolution #11-19. Resolution #11-19 accepts the rates and amounts as determined by the Delaware County Budget Commission and authorizes the necessary tax levies and certifies them to the Delaware County Auditor. Dave moved to approve Resolution #11-19 and Teresa seconded. All ayes.

The Board of Trustees signed the August 31, 2019 Bank Reconciliation.

There being no further business, Dave moved to adjourn and Dan seconded.


